WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW NOW FOR APPLICABLE STATE BENEFITS

Rhode Island employees ONLY

If you work in Rhode Island, you may be entitled to a Temporary Disability Insurance (TDI) benefit.

Who is eligible for this Temporary Disability Insurance?

TDI provides benefit payments to insured Rhode Island workers for weeks of unemployment caused by a temporary disability or injury. The TDI program, enacted in 1942, was the first of its kind in the United States. It protects workers against wage loss resulting from a non-work related illness or injury, and is funded exclusively by Rhode Island workers.

When should I apply?

You may **not** file your claim ahead of time. A TDI claim cannot be entered into the system until you are unemployed due to an illness/injury. If you file a claim ahead of time, the claim will be sent back to you (paper application) or cancelled (internet application).
