# Special Needs Initiative: Designed for families and children with complex health care needs\*

The Special Needs Initiative helps support families that have children (newborn to 17 years of age) with complex health care needs by providing a personalized, compassionate Care Advisor. The Advisor aims to help address questions and concerns, reduce the weight of member responsibility and ease anxiousness and stress, including social determinants of health (SDOH) support.

#### The Care Advisor:

- Takes a holistic approach to serving the whole family, not just the child with special health needs
- **Is trained** to remove obstacles, coordinate support with appropriate care teams and lessen member burden
- Personalizes and simplifies the member experience, and aims to help members avoid unexpected costs



About 14 million children under 18 years old (19%) have a special health care need


